They will have been educated on the importance of nutrition and academics through classroom sessions. Further, our athletes will walk away with a more refined on ice skill set through a series of drills and over 15 hours of on ice instruction geared towards working on the players individual strengths and weaknesses.

The Coaching staff will be assisted by current Revolution EJHL players to ensure that the student-instructor ratio remains low.

Junior Organization

For years the best players in the Philadelphia area have been forced to leave home at a young age in order to pursue their goals of playing College hockey in the NCAA. The EJHL, a 14 team New England based league, has placed over 50 student-athletes per season into NCAA D-I programs over 75 per year in NCAA D-III programs in each of the past 4 years (www.easternjunior.com).

When you look at the strong number of Philadelphia area players that are currently playing Junior hockey or Prep hockey elsewhere, it's evident that this area has been producing the talent necessary to field a top level Eastern Junior League team. Consider that since 2005 over 50 Philadelphia based players have moved out of the area to play in the EJ, USHL or NAHL. In addition to the D-I Prep school kids the number is well over 100. This is part of what has the management team with the Revolution excited and confident that this organization can develop into one of the premier programs in the EJHL.

The team will play a 45 game league schedule with the bulk of their road and showcase games played in the New England area. Home games will be at the Rink at Warwick. The team will practice Monday thru Friday with a full time coaching staff dedicated specifically to player development and college placement. Off ice sports performance training will be done through Bucks County based Evolving Athletes, LLC. Tryout information for the 2009-10 Philadelphia Revolution is listed below. Pre-registration is strongly recommended.
